



## AVTranz – NLRB contract

*AVTranz has been awarded 5 regions for digital court reporting and transcription.*

**October 4, 2010, Phoenix, AZ** – AVTranz today announced that it has been awarded a contract, projected to last 5-years, with the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) for court reporting and transcription services. The regions cover much of the western United States and include the main hubs of Los Angeles, Oakland and San Francisco, California as well as Portland, Oregon and Denver, Colorado. AVTranz will be responsible for servicing all NLRB hearings throughout Idaho, Utah, Nevada, Colorado, Wyoming, Montana and most of California and Oregon as well as parts of Arizona and Washington.

The contract calls for AVTranz to provide professional Digital Court Reporters to capture a record of hearings throughout the regions covered. It also requires verbatim transcripts be prepared in 1-, 3- or 10-day turnaround as required by participants.

"The National Labor Relations Board is an independent federal agency vested with the authority to safeguard employees' rights to organize and determine whether to have a union as their collective bargaining representative. The Agency also acts to prevent and remedy unfair labor practices committed by private sector employers and unions, as well as cases arising from the United States Postal Service."

NLRB Administrative Law Judges conduct hearings and issue decisions based on complaints of unfair labor practices by employers or labor unions. In 2009, 1,166 formal complaints were filed resulting in 175 hearings being conducted. Formal hearings can last from one day to several weeks.

"AVTranz is well positioned for this contract," said Karen Samcoe, AVTranz' VP of Digital Reporting Services. To our knowledge, this is the first time an Arizona company has been awarded a federal court reporting contract of this size."
